Hospice claims are currently under heavy scrutiny by Medicare, Medicaid, and other government entities. Program integrity contractors are now routinely employing statistical sampling with extrapolation as part of their audits, which often results in exceptionally large overpayment demands. DOJ also routinely uses extrapolation in False Claims Act matters to streamline its investigations and demand enormous payments and penalties from hospices while only examining a relatively small number of claims. At the same time, as part of their own self-audit process, hospice organizations may employ sampling. Understanding how this sampling process works and the rules of the road is important when involved in government audits and investigations and potential voluntary repayment situations.
